Dear Artists and Crafters:

The South Cobb Arts Alliance is pleased to invite you to participate in the 26th Annual Christmas House Arts and Crafts Show at the Mable House Arts Center December 3 – 12, 2010. This juried show offers to the public a 10-day holiday shopping experience in a beautifully decorated setting. From the Christmas trees covered in handmade ornaments to jewelry and fiber art, the Christmas House offers a broad selection of affordable, fine handcrafted gift items.

Unlike shows where booths are lined up along the walls and vendors must be present the entire show, the Christmas House provides a beautifully decorated venue and an experienced team of decorators to arrange the items in a setting more like a department store. Each vendor is required to work a minimum of eight hours during the ten-day show.

Entry fee is \$85.00 for SCAA members and \$120.00 for non-members. No more than two artists, working on the same body of work, may apply on one application. The application deadline is August 1, 2010. A maximum of 65 vendors will be selected with limits in each category.

You will be notified either by e-mail or postal service. Acceptance packets will contain a vendor number, instructions on how to tag your items, delivery and pick up dates, and directions to the Arts Center.

Application Rules and Show Information

HANDMADE WORK ONLY!! ABSOLUTELY NO MANUFACTURED GOODS WILL BE ACCEPTED nor anything made from kits. The Christmas House is designed to showcase original, handmade, unique fine crafts. The CH Committee will reject any items not deemed appropriate for the show, including poor craftsmanship and items that are not at least **70%** handmade. The CH Committee reserves the right to refuse any items at check-in that do not meet the quality standards set for this show.

Handmade **fine** jewelry is acceptable in the following media: hand cut stones, metal, wire wrapped, clay, paper, fabric, hand-painted wood. Handmade **novelty** jewelry will have a separate display area.

Deadline is August 1, 2010. Clear photographs of representative samples of your work must be included with a description of your process on the back of each photo. No more than three items in each photo for each category. Any items not listed on your application and not shown in the photographs will not be accepted at delivery. Example: If you show dolls in the photos and bring ornaments and dolls, the ornaments will not be accepted. Entry fees will be returned to exhibitors not accepted into the Christmas House. **No refunds for cancellations. Exceptions for emergencies only will be considered individually.**

Each crafter is required to volunteer a minimum of eight (8) hours. You may elect to work in the Christmas House, Mable's Tea Room, and/or the Concerts in the Tea Room. Be sure to indicate on your application the date(s) and time(s) you prefer to work. We will make every effort to accommodate your schedule, but shifts will be assigned on a first-come first-served basis. If no times are indicated, you will be assigned a shift. If you are unable to work and do not have someone to work in your place, the Christmas House Committee will assess a 25% commission of your total sales that will go to the South Cobb Arts Alliance.

The Mable House Arts Center has an excellent alarm system, and the Christmas House Committee will take precautions to eliminate the possibility of loss or theft. However, neither the South Cobb Arts Alliance, Cobb County Board of Commissioners, Cobb County Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs Department, nor any organization affiliated with the Mable House Arts Center will be held responsible for lost, broken or stolen items. Insurance is the sole responsibility of the applicant.

At check-in, items will be compared to photos, and tags will be checked. You will then be directed to an area of the Arts Center for unpacking your items. Please understand that all of your items may not all be displayed in one area.

Once the displays are set by the Committee, no one will be permitted to move items. The Committee will neaten the displays, rearrange and re-stock on a daily basis. You will be required to furnish small baskets/containers for small items such as pins, ornaments, etc. Your name and phone number must be attached to the bottom of each container. Re-stocking is permitted after Wednesday and must be approved by the Committee Chair. Do not re-stock without prior approval.
